At the regular scheduled Church Council meeting on Tuesday, August 28, Chairman Bill reported that the CID-CEF board did <u>not</u> approve our request to restructure our current mortgage, but they did offer a temporary three year payment reduction plan, followed by catchup payments for the remaining term of the loan. The council decided to continue with the monthly payments as long as funds are available. Voters had approved the restructuring request at the July meeting to allow for more budgetary flexibility.
